Multigenerational Living Home Renovation (CRA - Federal Tax Credit)

Home Accessibility Tax Credit (Federal Tax Credit)

Line 31285 – Home accessibility expenses - Canada.ca This tax credit is for individuals (or caregivers) <u>owning a home</u>, condo or within a co-operatively owned building only). Note: This is <u>not applicable to rental properties</u>.

Note: <u>There is no longer an Ontario Tax Credit for Seniors for Aging in Place</u> <u>Renovations</u> (for proactive renovations for accessibility + safety). However, the *Ontario Seniors Care at Home Tax Credit* is a refundable personal income tax credit to help <u>low- to moderate-income</u> seniors with eligible medical expenses, including expenses that support aging at home or one's place of residence. <u>https://www.ontario.ca/page/ontario-seniors-care-home-taxcredit</u>
